

National Food Safety Week 2007 will be held 12-19 November 2007

*This year is the 10th anniversary of the Food Safety Information Council, the Australian Government agency which aims to communicate and train industry in food safety. Every year the Council has a food safety week. This year, Food Safety Week will be held on 12th-19th November. The theme for the week will be **Back to Basics** focusing on the main food safety messages – Clean, Cook, Chill and Separate.*

A new scorecard of Australian's uptake of these basic food safety messages will be launched during Food Safety Week. The scorecard is based on annual tracking research the Council has undertaken to assess its Food Safety Campaign.

In addition, a range of activities at National, State and local levels are being held throughout Australia.
